

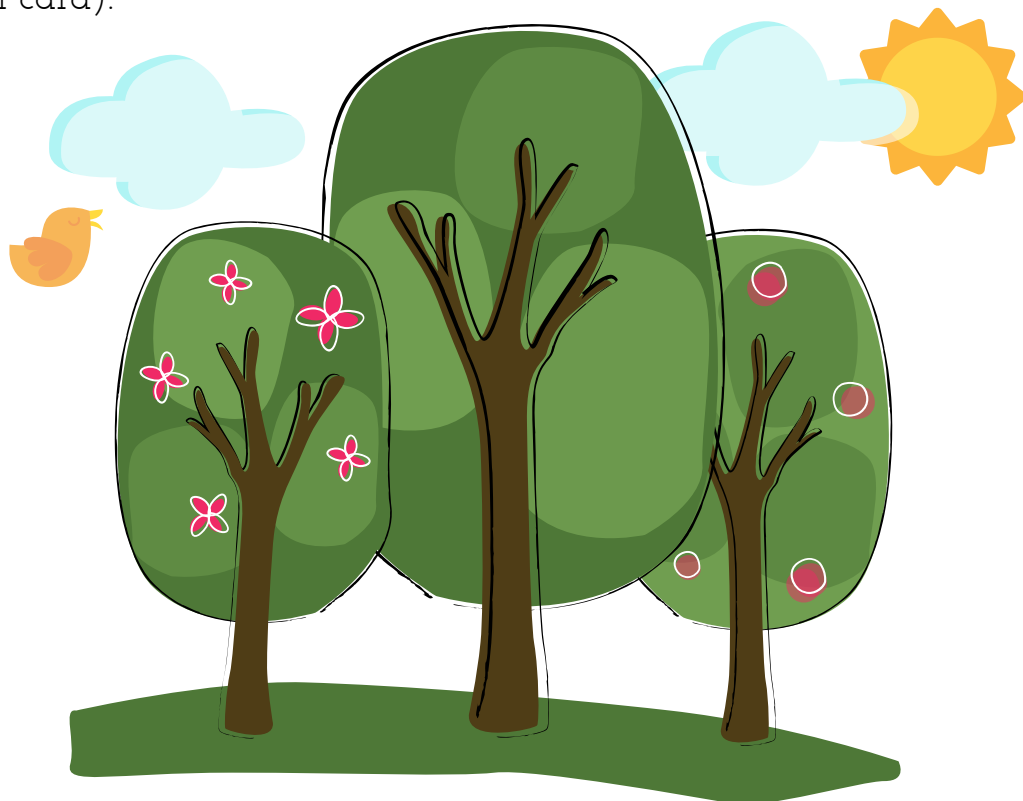
Tagalog Matching Game

Spring Words

Directions:

Learn & review the Tagalog words in the Tagalog/English Word Bank on the next 2 pages.

When you're familiar with the vocabulary, cut out the picture cards on pages 4 - 7. There are 2 decks of cards: The English deck and the Tagalog Deck. Keep the same deck together. Shuffle the cards within the same deck and place the cards face down, keeping the English deck on one side of the table and the Tagalog deck to the right of the English deck. Flip one card over from the English deck to reveal the word & picture. Flip a card over from the Tagalog deck to match the meaning. If you have a match, you can have another turn. If you don't have a matching pair, the next player may take a turn. You may also play solo and continue flipping to match pairs. (As another option, you may also flip over a card from the Tagalog deck first and then try to match the English card).
